The reporting of outcomes has three stages:

- 1. **Define**: Once, at the beginning of the loan or investment, Social Purpose Organizations enter information about their Organization, the stakeholders that aim to benefit, the expected or intended Outcomes, and indicators chosen to measure outcomes.
- 2. **Report**: At regular intervals, as agreed with the investor or lender, the Social Purpose Organization reports on their performance using the indicators they identified.
- 3. **Analyse**: Using a different tool, designed to support analysis, reveral reports from several organizations can be amassed to understand the impact of a fund or loan at the level of the intermediary or wholesaler.
